Notes for Adam Rutherford:

From notes compiled by Fermanah Patterson Rutherford (1868-1953) and from a letter "RUTHERFORD FAMILY HISTORY" from John Clayton Rutherford:

"Grandfather Adam Rutherford was employed in the wholesale house founded by Sir John Rutherford at the time he enlisted as an officer in the British Army in 1814. He was enrolled with the famous cavalry company called the Eniskillen Dragoons and took part in the battle of Waterloo in 1815. He was wounded in this battle when his leg was crush when his horse was shot down. On his retirement from the British Army he was awarded a free grant of 400 acres of land, with the privilege of making his own selection anywhere in Canada. But, at the time there was so much land, and Canada was such a big country, that grandfather deferred making his selection from time to time and wound up by never filing at all.

It seems that some time after Waterloo, grandfather, then a dashing young officer, was stationed in Edinburgh, as a recuiting officer. He fell in love with the beautiful and aristocratic Jane Borthwick of Borthwick Castle, but the affair, meeting with the stern dissapproval of the head of the house of Borthwick, an elopement was staged and the couple succeeded in eluding their pursuers and in making their way to Ireland. Jane was never again accepted into the House of Borthwick."

In a letter from Gail Rutherford Minor (early 1990s): "The ledger in Edinburgh reads: Adam Rutherford, CORP., 6 DRAGOON GUARDS, PIERSHEIL BARRACKS."

The Autobiography of F.P.Rutherford states that Adam Rutherford's birth was 1794; other information stated 1784. It also states that Jane Borthwick's maiden surname could have been either Borthwick or Borthwig. And that Adam emigrated to Canada around 1935.

"BENCHMARKS" book, page 158 ("May 1878 - David Rutherford was pathmaster for the Government Road, Lots 1 to 10."). Page 484, "David Rutherford and Margaret McKnight came to Eastnor from Owen Sound area in 1876 with ten children, built a log house and barn, and cleared the farmed Lot 17, Con. 2, W.B.R. (West Bury Road). Children: Anne, Adam, James, David, Isabella, Sam Luther, Georgena, Fermanah Patterson and John Robert." Page 473, also lists the land on Lot 17, Con. 2, W.B.R.

The tombstone of David Rutherford confirms his deathdate of Sept 1, 1909 and is consistant with his age at death of "77 YRS 9 Ms".

The Autobiography of F.P.Rutherford contains a lot of information about this family and their activities over the years. David Rutherford was the father of F.P.Rutherford.
